Revise the standard Radio Button Size

Radio buttons are not rendering properly in Visual Studio because of a style issue. This guide will have you update the styles to render radio buttons normally.

A. Adding a style for radio buttons versus the default style which is 300px wide.

1. Open the site.css file in the Content folder
2. Search for the textarea styles (control F – textarea)
3. After the input, textarea style add the following style

```
input[type='radio']{  
    border: 1px solid #e2e2e2;  
    background: #fff;  
    color: #333;  
    font-size: 1.2em;  
    margin: 5px 0 6px 0;  
    padding: 5px;  
    width: 25px;  
}
```

4. Add another to place the label (Yes, No etc) beside the button

```
label { width: auto; display: inline; }
```
5. Save
6. Implement the style by applying a CSSClass to your radio buttons as in
CSSClass = radio
