#### Where and When

Hochschule Bremen, Germany Arrive June 1, 2025 Depart June 27, 2025

You may travel before or after on your own or with other students

#### Costs

- Program Fee: \$2200 (est), this includes:
  - lodging while in Bremen
  - health insurance
  - welcoming dinner
  - walking tour of Bremen
  - group tours (tentative)
- Tuition: \$550 (per course) to UNCW (in state)
- Germany Transit Pass: ~49€
- Airfare: approx. \$1200 to \$1500 (depends on your departure/arrival cities)
- Other expenses on your own, meals, travel to other cities

\*Program fee assumes 20 students and no major change in the euro exchange rate

# **UNCW Orientation Sessions**

After a student is accepted to attend any overseas summer school program, the UNCW Office of International Programs puts on a series of required information sessions to help students prepare for their international experience. UNCW-OIP also gives the students a handbook with lots of useful information, etc.

#### **Fall/Winter Activities**

- Start thinking about potential roommates,
- Be prepared to pay \$500 nonrefundable deposit by early March
- Be prepared to pay remainder of program fee by early April (estimated at \$1800) and tuition for the 2 summer courses the normal time frame for the tuition payment is Summer 2
- Travel Scholarships are available if you apply and pay the deposit by 4/1
- Determine your courses
- Bremen will require you to register on their home page in order to get a HS Bremen student ID and bus pass, photo needed

### **Transportation**

- Your arrival with proper notice a UNCW faculty member will greet you at the airport or train station and assist you to get to the hotel.
- City Travel Students will purchase an monthly Deutschland Pass for travel in all of Germany, including subways, busses and trains in Bremen and other cities (excludes hi speed trains).
- Airport The Bremen Airport code is BRE, many students fly to another city, spend a few days and the take the train to Bremen.
- Trains railEurope or euRail are good sites to investigate if going to other countries, you can purchase day of tickets right in the Bremen train station.

**Bike Rental -** there is a bike rental shop near the main train station. Last year the rate was \$10 euros for the day. There are plenty of great bike trails along the river and into the country side. A bike is a"Fahrrad (Fahr-rahd)" radstation-bremen.de\

#### **Health Insurance**

is included in the program fee. In May, you will receive an email from the health insurance company "HTH". You can purchase additional coverage for before /after the trip
